Open

Birthmother is involved in child placement and continues a relationship with adoptive family

Semi Open

Birthmother has indirect contact with adoptive family but can remain updated on child's life

Closed

Birthmother has no contact and knows little or nothing about adoptive family

Choosing adoption

If adoption is chosen, case managers will assist with counseling parents on their pregnancy decision, provide pre-natal & post-natal care resources, offer both legal & financial help, and offer postpartum counseling.

Adoption process

- 1. Coordinate**
Counseling and initial intake will take place with birthmother. Case managers then coordinate information to begin the adoption process
- 2. Profile Books**
Birthmother is then shown potential adoptive family profile books
- 3. Meeting**
Following a family selection, an unofficial meeting takes place between family and birthparent
- 4. Match Meeting**
During the match meeting, three major topics are discussed
- 5. Finalization**
Paperwork is completed and postpartum counseling can begin
