WE PROVIDE:

- Home study services
- Experienced staff who meet with the birth parent(s) regularly and are available for consultation, counseling, and support.
- Matching expectant birth parents with prospective adoptive parents
- Adoption finalization
- Post-placement services

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be 23-49 years old
- Must live within Dallas or Fort Worth Diocese or any location not served by another Catholic Charities
- Both adoptive parents must have a clean criminal background check (State of Texas) and Child Adult Protective Services (CAPS) check, and an FBI clearance by fingerprints. Each person over 14 years of age in the adoptive home must go through and be cleared by the same process.
- At least one parent must be a United States citizen or must provide proof of legal status
