Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Here, in the Diocese of Dallas, it is a **Time for Giving**. We know that time is a gift from God! How often do you end your day, surprised at how fast it ended? 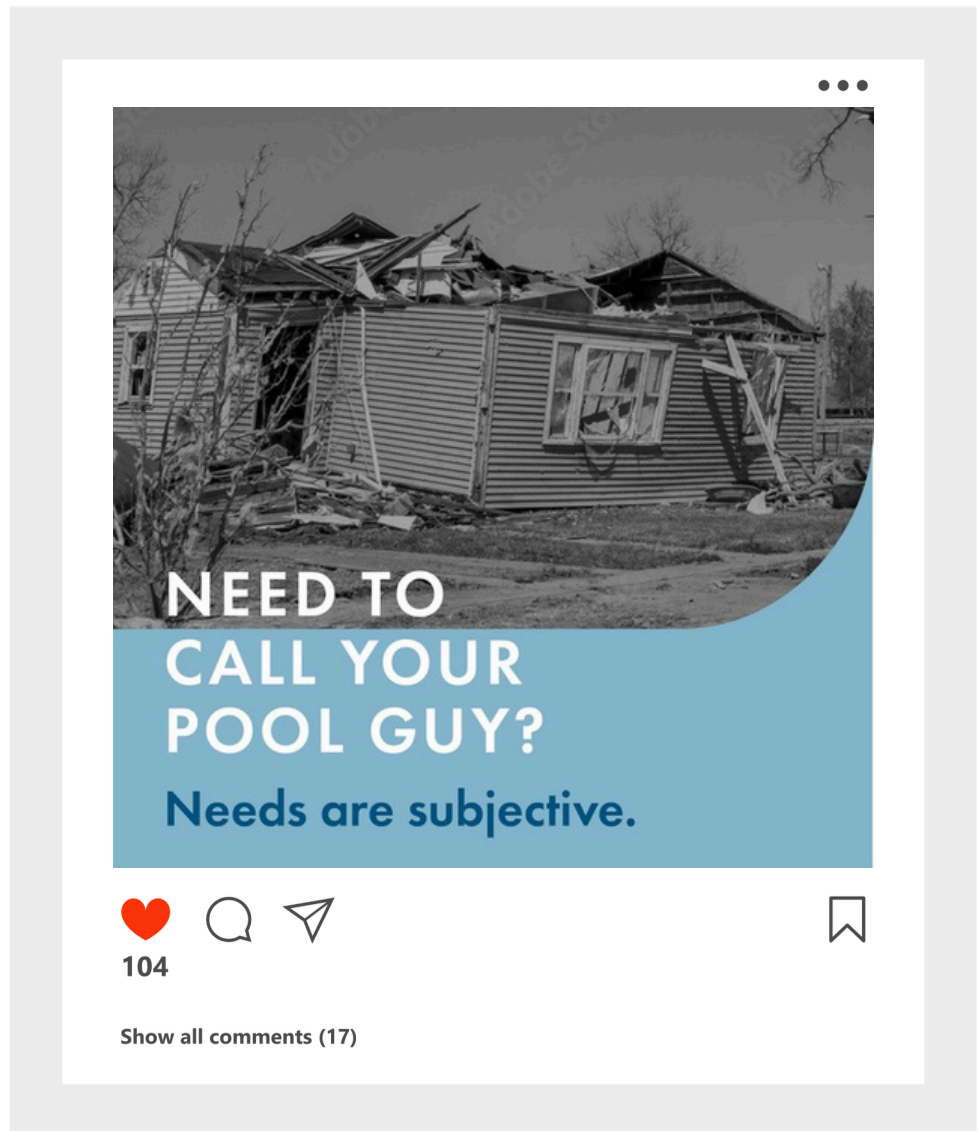
Coming soon

Across our diocese, we are seeking support for Catholic Charities Dallas' annual appeal, Time for Giving. Now, more than ever before, our neighbors are in need. This annual campaign helps fund the work of CCD serving the "least among us." Time for Giving represents the chance for us all to respond in love and generosity to our brothers and sisters in need. Please respond generously to ensure CCD can continue touching thousands of lives each year across North Texas. Your donation helps Catholic Charities Dallas:

- Care for the formerly homeless - \$100 buys essential household items, like toilet paper, hygiene products, and cleaning supplies for a person exiting homelessness.
- Educate the disadvantaged - \$250 a month provides early learning kits for preschool children in our Together We Learn program.
- Feed the hungry – \$500 provides meals for over 2,600 people.
- Provide emergency relief - \$1,500 covers one month of rent for a family displaced by disaster.

Catholic Charities Time for Giving message to be presented by a priest or deacon

As we heard in today's second reading, we have been "called out of darkness into Christ's wonderful light." (1 Peter 2:9) Our world is full of darkness, and yet, by the grace of God, the light of Christ prevails. Catholic Charities is spreading the light of Christ in our diocese by uplifting our brothers and sisters in need. For over 130 years, Catholic Charities has fed the hungry, sheltered the homeless, welcomed the stranger, and created hope for those in our community and in our own parish who are most vulnerable and most in need.

On behalf of Catholic Charities, I would like to share what they do and how Jesus calls us to walk with them in service of others. In our diocese, over 200,000 individuals and families were served through Catholic Charities' 11 missions and 39+ programs last year. CCD distributed nearly 8 million meals and hundreds of thousands of diapers to individuals and families. Their Brady Center provided our growing senior population with access to essential resources and a safe place to enjoy community, congregate for meals, and participate in stimulating activities. They opened new doors to more than 2,000 children and their parents by providing educational services to build literacy skills across generations. Those are just a few of the many ways CCD has provided hope to thousands in our community.

As your pastor/priest/deacon, I want to personally thank you for your past support of the charitable mission of the Church through Catholic Charities' Time for Giving annual appeal. Time for Giving / CCD second collection weekend is an invitation for all of us in the Diocese of Dallas to unite and respond with joy and gratitude for the gifts God has given us, and to reach out in love to those among us who are less fortunate.
